Camberwell Girls Grammar School offers a limited number of Means-Tested Scholarships to eligible families who are on a limited income. Means-Tested Scholarships are for entry at Years 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11. Scholarships are tenable until the end of Year 12. Means-Tested Scholarships are awarded based on a candidate's scholarship examination results, participation in the Scholarship Interactive Evening, latest school report, NAPLAN report, scholarship interview and financial circumstances.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- > Candidates must be Australian or New Zealand Citizens, or Permanent Residents in Australia. If shortlisted, we will request prior to the interview: Australian citizen - birth certificate and Australian passport or Citizenship by Descent; Permanent resident - birth certificate, passport and Australian residency visa.
- > Eligible Camberwell Girls Grammar School students may apply for the Means-Tested Scholarship
- > Students are to be age and year level-appropriate
- > Photo ID is required on the day of the scholarship examination
- > Financial information must accompany the application (see below for further details)

STEP 3 / CONFIDENTIAL STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

Contact the Admissions Manager to request a copy of the Confidential Statement of Financial Circumstances Form – email admissions@cggs.vic.edu.au. The Admissions Manager will email a copy of the Confidential Statement of Financial Circumstances Form to be completed and returned with supporting documentation.

STEP 4 / SUBMIT DOCUMENTATION

1. Following your application for the scholarship exam, Edutest will send a confirmation email with a link to upload the following documents:

- > Latest school report
- > Latest NAPLAN report

We request that you only submit the requested documents above. Additional documentation such as certificates, awards etc. will not be taken into consideration when assessing scholarship applications.

2. Provide financial information by completing the Confidential Statement of Financial Circumstances Form along with a Covering Letter outlining the circumstances and reason for applying for a Means-Tested Scholarship. Attach supporting documents including income tax returns and financial statements and email to the Finance Manager to:

Testing Day Information

Once you have registered online, you will receive further information from Edutest *via email* in the week leading up to the scholarship exam including what to bring on the day. This is generally sent the Monday or Tuesday prior to testing day.

Results

Shortlisted candidates will be contacted by the school for an interview with the Principal / Head of School, generally 2 to 3 weeks after the testing. An Edutest scholarship report will be sent to unsuccessful candidates at the end of Term 1 or beginning of Term 2, 2023 once the scholarship process is completed.

Scholarship Terms & Conditions

Means-Tested Scholarships apply to tuition fees and do not cover composite fees, private music lessons, activities such as specialist camps and exchanges, school uniform, textbooks / resources or IT requirements.

- > Scholarship holders are expected to complete their education at CGGS and maintain a high standard of academic achievement, participate in the life of the school and be a positive member of the school community. The performance of each student is reviewed annually. In the event of a student's withdrawal prior to completing their education, the full value of the Scholarship up to that time will be repayable to the school.
- > No Scholarship holder may hold more than one Scholarship.
- > A sibling discount does not apply to a Scholarship holder.

Value of Scholarships

Scholarships are awarded at the Principal's discretion. The number of scholarships offered, and the percentage of tuition fee remission will vary according to the calibre of the candidates.
