

Statement of Democratic Principles

The Minimum Standards for registration of schools require that the programs and teaching at Camberwell Girls Grammar School must support and promote the principles and practice of Australian democracy.

- We believe in the value of freedom of speech and freedom of association, but also acknowledge that we have the responsibility not to abuse this freedom.
