Academic Excellence Scholarships are offered to new and current students entering Years 5 and 7 to 11 in 2026 and are tenable until the end of Year 12. Academic Excellence Scholarships are awarded based on scholarship examination results, participation in the Scholarship Interactive Session, latest school report, NAPLAN report and interview.

Eligibility Criteria

- Candidates must be Australian or New Zealand Citizens, or Permanent Residents in Australia.
- The Academic Excellence Scholarship is open to new students and Camberwell Girls Grammar School students.
- Students are to be age and year level appropriate.
- ◆ Photo ID is required on the day of the scholarship examination e.g. passport, school class photo.

Step 1 / Register for the Edutest Scholarship Exam

Register for the scholarship exam online via the Camberwell Girls website https://cggs.vic.edu.au/enrolment/scholarships Click on the 'Apply' button.

Applications close Friday 31 January 2025.

Step 2 / RSVP for the Scholarship Interactive Session

Step 3 / Attend Scholarship Events at CGGS

- Sit the Scholarship Exam Saturday, 15 February 2025

Step 4 / Shortlisted Applicants

Once the exam results are received, applicants will be shortlisted for an interview. Shortlisted applicants will be contacted by Admissions to arrange an interview with a member of the Scholarship panel. You will also be asked to provide the following documents prior to your interview- PDF format preferred:

- ◆ Latest school report Semester 1, 2024 or Semester 2, 2024 (if available)
- Latest NAPLAN report



Important: Please submit only the requested documents above. Additional documentation, such as certificates, awards, etc., will not be considered when assessing scholarship applications.

Frequently Asked Questions

Testing Day Information

Once you have registered online, you will receive further information from Edutest via email in the week leading up to the scholarship exam including what to bring on the day. This is generally sent the Monday prior to testing day.

Results

The School will contact shortlisted candidates for an interview with the Principal / Head of School, generally 2 to 3 weeks after the testing. Once the scholarship process is complete, an Edutest scholarship report will be sent to unsuccessful candidates at the beginning of Term 2, 2025.

Scholarship Terms & Conditions

Academic Excellence scholarships apply to tuition fees and do not cover composite fees, private music lessons, activities such as specialist camps and exchanges, school uniform, textbooks / resources or IT requirements. You can view our full Scholarship Terms and Conditions here.

Value of Scholarships

Scholarships are awarded at the principal's discretion. The number of scholarships offered, and the percentage of tuition fee remission will vary according to the calibre of the candidates.
