A limited number of Means-Tested Scholarships are available to new and current students entering Years 7 to 11 in 2026 and are tenable until the end of Year 12. These scholarships are awarded based on scholarship examination results, participation in the Scholarship Interactive Session, latest school report, NAPLAN report, a scholarship interview, and demonstrated financial need.

# **Eligibility Criteria**

- Candidates must be Australian or New Zealand Citizens, or Permanent Residents in Australia.
- The Means-Tested Scholarship is open to new students and Camberwell Girls Grammar School students.
- Students are to be age and year level appropriate
- Photo ID is required on the day of the scholarship examination e.g. passport, school class photo.
- Financial information must accompany the application (see below for further details)

# Step 1 / Register for the Edutest Scholarship Exam

## Step 3 / Confidential Statement of Financial Circumstances

Contact the Head of Admissions to request the Confidential Statement of Financial Circumstances Form – email <u>admissions@cggs.vic.edu.au</u>. The form should be completed and returned with the relevant documentation.

## Step 5 / Attend Scholarship Events at CGGS

- We encourage you to attend our Open Morning Thursday 6 February 2025
- Attend the compulsory Scholarship Interactive Session Wednesday 12 February 2025
- Sit the Scholarship Exam Saturday, 15 February 2025

## Step 4 / Shortlisted applicants

Once the exam results are received and if an applicant meets the criteria for a 'Means-Tested Scholarship, applicants will be shortlisted for an interview. Shortlisted applicants will be contact by Admissions to arrange an



interview with a member of the Scholarship panel. You will also be asked to provide the following documents prior to your interview- PDF format preferred:

- Latest school report Semester 1, 2024 or Semester 2, 2024 (if available)
- Latest NAPLAN report

**Important: We request that you only submit the requested documents above.** Additional documentation such as certificates, awards etc. will not be taken into consideration when assessing scholarship applications.

# **Frequently Asked Questions**

## **Testing Day Information**

Once you have registered online, you will receive further information from Edutest via email in the week leading up to the scholarship exam including what to bring on the day. This is generally sent the Monday prior to testing day.

#### **Results**

The School will contact shortlisted candidates for an interview with the Principal / Head of School, generally 2 to 3 weeks after the testing. Once the scholarship process is complete, an Edutest scholarship report will be sent to unsuccessful candidates at the beginning of Term 2, 2025.

#### **Scholarship Terms & Conditions**

Means-Tested scholarships apply to tuition fees and do not cover composite fees, private music lessons, activities such as specialist camps and exchanges, school uniform, textbooks / resources or IT requirements. You can view our full <u>Scholarship Terms and Conditions here.</u>

Scholarships are awarded at the principal's discretion. The number of scholarships offered, and the percentage of tuition fee remission will vary according to the calibre of the candidates.
