Applications Open:	Monday 10 November 2025 at 9.00am
Applications Close:	Friday 30 January 2026 at 5.00pm. Late applications will not be accepted.

Scholarship Interactive Session:	Session 1- Year 7 2027- Wednesday 11 February 2026, 4.30pm – 6.30pm (Compulsory for all applicants). Session 2- Years 8-11 2027- Thursday 19 February 2026, 4.30pm – 6.30pm (Compulsory for all applicants).
Examination Date:	Saturday 14 February 2026, 8.30am arrival for a 9.00am start – 12.00pm midday.

Principal's Scholarships for Service are offered to new and current students entering Years 7 to 11 in 2027 and are tenable until the end of Year 12. Applicants who demonstrate the School's values of Integrity, Commitment, Respect, Hope, and Courage in their co-curricular and community activities are encouraged to apply. Principal's Scholarships for Service are awarded based on a candidate's application, scholarship examination results, participation in the Scholarship Interactive Session, latest school report, NAPLAN report and interview.

Eligibility Criteria

- ◆ Candidates **must be** Australian or New Zealand Citizens, or Permanent Residents in Australia. **Temporary Residents are not eligible.**
- ◆ The Principal's Scholarship for Service is open to new students and current Camberwell Girls Grammar School students.
- ◆ Students are to be age and year level appropriate.
- ◆ Photo ID is required on the day of the scholarship examination e.g. passport, school class photo.

Application Process

Step 1 / Register for the Edutest Scholarship Exam and Scholarship Interactive Session

Click 'Apply' on the [Camberwell Girls website](#) to register for the scholarship exam. Once registered, you will be sent a calendar invite for the compulsory Scholarship Interactive at Camberwell Girls.

Applications close **Friday 30 January 2026 at 5.00pm.**

Step 2 / Complete the online Principal's Scholarship for Service Application Form

- ◆ Admissions will email you a link to the online Principal's Scholarship for Service application form once you have registered for the Edutest Exam and Scholarship Interactive Session. This is a Microsoft Form and must be completed by the due date as part of the application process.

You will be required to detail:

- ◆ Examples that demonstrate your character and contributions to others at home or in the broader community.
- ◆ Examples of where you have demonstrated sustained and meaningful engagement within a co-curricular commitment and why it is important.
- ◆ Up to 8 co-curricular achievements you are most proud of and why.

Step 3 / Attend Scholarship Events at Camberwell Girls

- ◆ We encourage you to attend our Open Morning - **Thursday 5 February 2026**. Bookings can be made [via the School website](#).
- ◆ Attend the compulsory Scholarship Interactive Session:
 - ◆ **Session 1**- Year 7 2027- **Wednesday 11 February 2026**
 - ◆ **Session 2**- Years 8-11 2027- **Thursday 19 February 2026**
- ◆ Sit the Scholarship Exam – **Saturday 14 February 2026**

Step 4 / Shortlisted applicants

Following your registration for the scholarship exam and completed Principal's Scholarship for Service application form, applicants will be shortlisted. Admissions will contact you to request the following documents- PDF format preferred:

- ◆ Latest school reports – Semester 1, 2025 and Semester 2, 2025
- ◆ Latest NAPLAN report

Important: Please only submit the requested documents above. Additional documentation, such as certificates and awards, will not be considered when evaluating scholarship applications.

Frequently Asked Questions

Applying for Multiple Scholarships

You can only apply for one scholarship type per year of entry at Camberwell Girls. E.g. if you apply for an Principal's Scholarship for Service, you can not apply for a Means-Tested scholarship in the same year as well.

Please note: Applicants who apply for the Principal's Scholarship for Service will also be **considered** for the Academic Excellence Scholarship.

A separate application is not required.

Testing Day Information

Once you have registered online, you will receive further information from Edutest via email in the week leading up to the scholarship exam including what to bring on the day. This is generally sent the Monday prior to testing day.

Results

The School will contact shortlisted candidates for an interview, generally 2 to 3 weeks after testing. Once the scholarship process is complete, an Edutest scholarship report will be sent to unsuccessful candidates at the beginning of Term 2, 2026.



Scholarship Terms & Conditions

Principal's Scholarship for Service apply to tuition fees and do not cover composite fees, private music lessons, activities such as specialist camps and exchanges, school uniform, textbooks / resources or IT requirements. You can view our full [Scholarship Terms and Conditions here](#).

Scholarships are awarded at the principal's discretion. The number of scholarships offered, and the percentage of tuition fee remission will vary according to the calibre of the candidates.
